THE NATIONAL GALLERY OF CANADA



Designed by Canadian Israeli architect Moshe Safdi, the glass and granite building hosts thousands of art works. On the Ottawa River, facing Notre-Dame Cathedral, it neighbours the Byward Market, the USA Embassy, Château Laurier and Rideau Center. Also close to the Rideau Canal.

THE CANADIAN MUSEUM OF HISTORY


Across the Ottawa River from Parliament Hill, stands the Museum conceived by the metis architect Douglas Cardinal to represent the "flowing contours of the land". The northern curatorial wing evokes the Canadian Shield. The southern public wing with its glass fronted Grand Hall evokes a melting glacier.



DIEFENBUNKER MUSEUM

Built between 1959 & 1961, the four-storey underground bunker was to shelter top Canadian officials in case of a nuclear war. Canadian forces occupied it until 1994. It is now a museum open to the public.
